Interested bidders should attend this meeting to understand and clarify the scope of work and intent of bid documents. Any bidder, who is not in attendance at this meeting, will be held responsible for the understanding and extent of the scope of work and the contract.
- 4. Bid forms and contract documents are on file as of 1:00 PM on April 23rd, 2018, at the Housing Authority Office. Copies of these documents may be obtained by depositing a \$50.00 check (COMPANY CHECK or MONEY ORDER ONLY, NO CASH) made payable to The Housing Authority of the City of New Britain for each set of documents so obtained. Such deposit will be non-refundable
- 5. Each bidder is required to submit with their bid, a bid guarantee of not less than 5% of the amount of the bid in the form of a certified check or bank draft, U.S. Government Bonds at par value, an irrevocable letter of credit or a bid bond secured by a surety company.
- 6. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance and payment bond for 100% of the contract price; or a 100% cash escrow; or a 25% irrevocable letter of credit. The surety must be a guarantee or surety company acceptable to the Housing Authority and licensed to provide sureties in the State of Connecticut. Individual sureties will not be considered.
- 7. The Housing Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 90 days subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of the Housing Authority.
